Join us and learn how to create a portable medical summary of your child's care, services, providers, and progress notes.

Family to Family Health Information Center at the PEAL Center is pleased to offer workshops for parents of children with Special Health Care Needs (SHCN) and youth with SHCN to learn how to build an electronic healthcare notebook (portable medical summary). The workshop is free to all participants and PEAL will provide a 1 GIG Flash Drive to electronically store your notebook work. Space is limited so complete your registration as soon as possible!

WHAT is an Electronic Healthcare Notebook?

The electronic notebook will help parents/caregivers/youth maintain an ongoing record of their child's care, services, providers, and progress notes. It is a great tool in empowering families to become the experts on their child's care. It is also a way to maintain the lines of communication between the many providers and services that help care for a child and their family.

WHY build your own Electronic Healthcare Notebook?

The electronic notebook is an organizational tool for families and will help you keep track of important health information. Electronic Notebooks are very personal to your child and ideally should be customized to reflect your child's medical history and current information. For this reason, this training will allow you to build an Electronic Healthcare Notebook that best meets the needs of your child. We will talk about methods of keeping your records on your Flash Drive up to date and sharing this information with healthcare providers.

HOW will I build my own Electronic Healthcare Notebook during training?

Through tutorials and practical exercises on the computer, the workshop will guide you through a process to create your own customized notebook. The workshop will last about 1 1/2 -2 hours and will be geared for beginners, intermediates, and advanced computer users. You will leave with a Flash Drive with your own Healthcare Notebook containing the information you bring to the workshop.

WHAT should I bring to the workshop?

You will actually begin creating your electronic notebook and saving it to the 1 GIG Flash Drive you will receive. Bring some records with you, such as doctors, specialists and other providers' names and contact information. You may also want to bring some actual healthcare records such as vaccinations, recent appointments, upcoming appointment dates, or recent test information.
